Please be advised that all shipments being imported to the United States assigned to a U.S. Government contract, or otherwise defense related, must include a Duty Free Entry clause as shown below. The only time this does not apply is when the entry is being imported under a commercial contract.

When shipping via CEVA Logistics:

Upon arrival of shipment at the appropriate port of entry, Port Director of Customs, please notify CEVA Logistics and release shipment under 19 CFR Part 142 to this party.

When shipping via DHL Express:

United States Government, Department of Defense – Duty Free Entry to be claimed pursuant to Section XXII, Chapter 98 Subchapter VIII, item 9808.00.30 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States. Upon arrival of shipment at the appropriate port of entry, Port Director of Customs, please notify *DHL Express* and release shipment under 19 CFR Part 142 to this party.

When shipping via UPS Freight or Landstar (Northern Border from Canada):

United States Government, Department of Defense – Duty Free Entry to be claimed pursuant to Section XXII, Chapter 98 Subchapter VIII, item 9808.00.30 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States. Upon arrival of shipment at the appropriate port of entry, Port Director of Customs, please notify *DHL Global Forwarding* and release shipment under 19 CFR Part 142 to this party.
